## *Vision*

Our vision is to see the worldwide family of God grow and flourish. We want to engage with the congregation, the local community and international missions partners in order to be effective in partnering with God in the expansion of His kingdom.

## *Giving*

As a church we set aside 10% of our church income, including offering income for overseas missions. Currently this means we have \$40,000 per annum to commit. This booklet contains a description of those mission projects and the funding allocated to them.

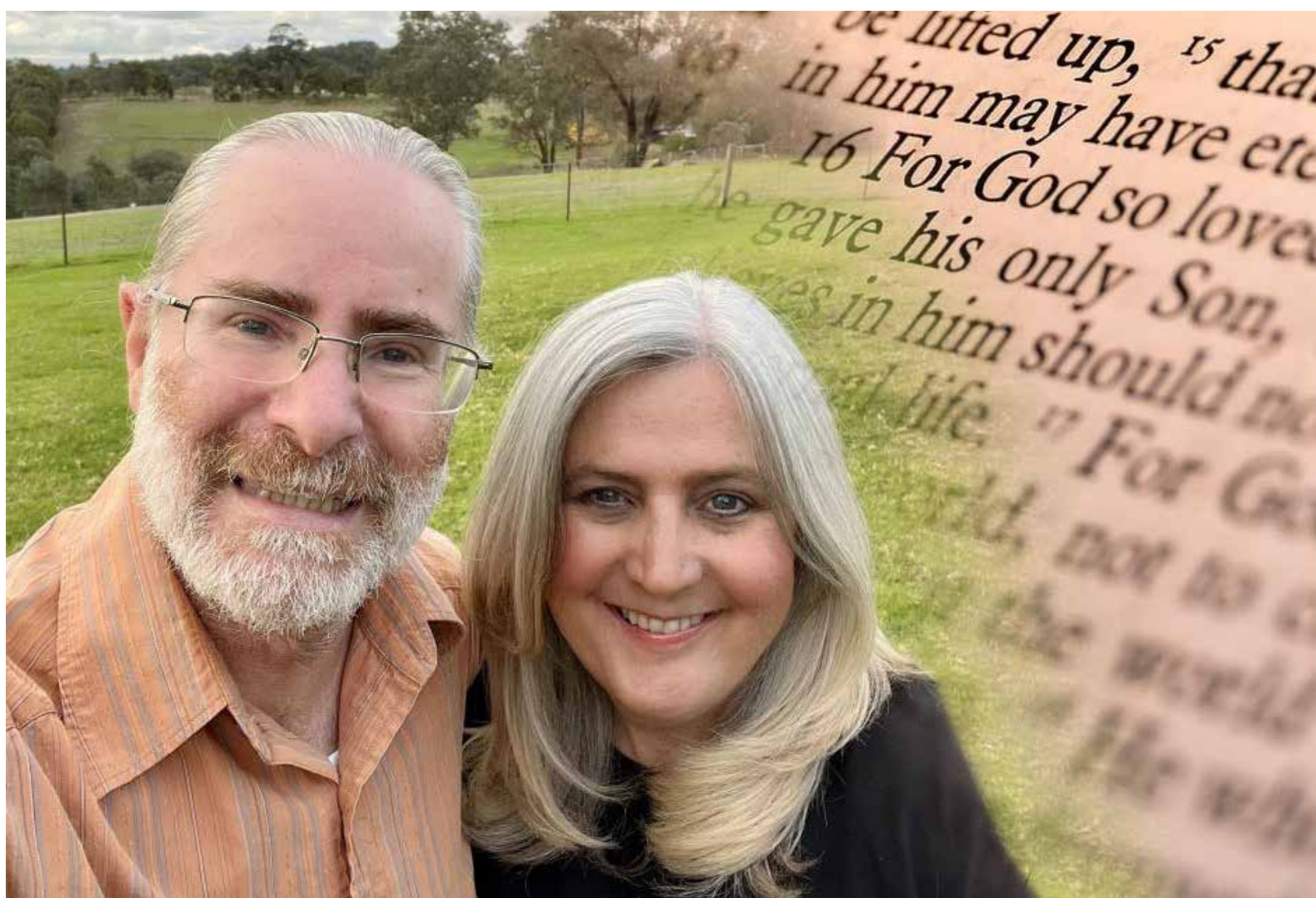
## *Commitment*

We have made a three-year commitment to each of these missions so they can know their funding is secured until at least the conclusion of 2025.

## *Team*

## **SOUTH EAST ASIA & GLOBAL**
