



Hi Church,

If you haven't already heard all of NZ is moving to alert level 4 as of midnight tonight. This is due to one community case in Auckland. We will keep you updated with implications for us as a church as we learn more, but this is what we can update you with so far:

1) Unless you are an essential worker, you ought to be at home until midnight Friday. Therefore all Connect Groups, Youth Groups, Prayer meetings, Toddlerock and CAMEO will not happen this week. Unless you want to do things by Zoom.

2) The Volunteers event scheduled for this Saturday will be postponed to a date later in the year. There is just too much uncertainty for us to prepare for this event over the next few days.

3) If we are at Level 1 or 2 by Sunday, we will have a church gathering on Sunday morning. We will operate with level 2 protocols if necessary. If we are at alert level 3 or 4 we will have a church service available online.

My encouragement is to keep in touch with each other. Use the time you have at home to pick up the phone and connect with someone else in the church.

Let us also pray for this to be contained quickly.
